Starting Monday, December 6th, the Village Hall will undergo repairs to the bell tower. During a recent storm with high winds the bell tower sustained structural damage. Because of the age and the existing condition on the tower, the wind damage made it a necessity to remove the tower. We will take the bell tower down and preserve it to the best of our ability. During these repairs, the Village offices will be open. The parking lot will be closed off and no one will be permitted to be in that area. We will be redirecting everyone to the side entrance located beside WesBanco Bank drive through. These repairs should just take a few days. We appreciate your patience and cooperation with this matter.


Please be considerate of your outside pets this winter. When the temperatures drop, it is very hard on your outside pets. I will not tolerate any cruelty to pets and this includes leaving them unprotected in the cold. I will intervene to protect the animals.

Please remember to let your water drip when the temperatures reach below 32 degrees. The freezing temperature will cause your pipes to freeze and possibly burst. Call the Water Office as soon as you realize you have a problem.

I am not sure if everyone is aware of the fact that we have a church in the Village. The Living Grace Bible Church is a non denominational church and they have Sunday School from 9:30 to 10:15 and worship from 10:30 to 11:30. Sunday evening worship service starts at 6:00 p.m. and Wednesday's services start at 7:00 p.m.

Finley United Methodist Chapel will have their live nativity scene at the Village Hall again this year. The dates are set for December 21-23.
